

Notice of Election
Greene County Community School District
Special Election

Notice is hereby given to the qualified electors of the Greene County Community School District in Greene and Boone Counties, State of Iowa, that a Special Election will be held on April 3, 2018 for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the school district a question to authorize to contract indebtedness and issue General Obligation Bonds.

The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

GREENE COUNTY COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT polling places are as follows:

Grand Junction Precinct, consisting of voters of the school district within the old East Greene Consolidated School District, more specifically described as: City of Dana, City of Grand Junction, City of Rippey, Dawson, Franklin, Grant, North and South Junction, Paton and Washington Townships, Greene County, Sections 6 & 7 of Amaqua Township and Sections 5, 6, 7 & 8 of Union Township, Boone County, will vote at St. Brigid Parish Center, Grand Junction, Iowa.

Jefferson Precinct, consisting of voters of the school district within the old Jefferson Consolidated School District: plus Bristol, Dawson, Franklin, Grant, Greenbrier, Hardin, Jackson Townships and a portion of Section 12 of Willow Township, Greene County, will vote at Clover Hall Fairgrounds, Jefferson, Iowa.

Scranton Precinct, consisting of voters of the school district within the old Scranton Consolidated School District more specifically described as: City of Scranton, Scranton Township and parts of Kendrick, Jackson and Willow Townships, Greene County, will vote at Scranton Community Room, Scranton Iowa.

If you are unsure of your polling place please contact the Auditor's Office at the telephone number or e-mail address listed below.

Voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before they may receive and cast a ballot. Pre-registered voters who are unable to show approved ID may sign an oath of identification for an election held in 2018. Voters who are not pre-registered or who have changed precincts also may be required to provide proof of residence. Any voter who cannot show ID may have their identity attested to by another registered voter in the precinct who has proper ID. Starting January 1, 2019, all voters will be required to present an approved form of identification.
