

**NOTICE OF PRIMARY ELECTION
GREENE COUNTY, IOWA
TUESDAY, JUNE 5, 2018**

Notice is hereby given to all eligible voters in Greene County, Iowa that a Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, June 5, 2018. Voters must declare a party affiliation (Republican, Democratic or Libertarian) to vote in this election. The polling places will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. A listing of precincts and their respective polling place locations are as follows:

Republican, Democratic and Libertarian ballot, of the first rotation, appear in this publication and ballots of similarity shall appear in the proper precincts.

Voters are advised as to the requirements of voter registration in order to be eligible to vote at said election. Friday, May 25, 2018 is the last day to pre-register to vote. This applies to registration in person (also registration at driver's license stations or agencies) or by mail. All voter registration forms must be received by the County Auditor no later than 5:00 p.m. on this day, unless postmarked on or before Monday, May 21, 2018. You may vote an absentee ballot at the County Auditor's office Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The County Auditor's Office will also be open on Saturday, June 2, 2018 from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. for absentee voting.

Voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before they may receive and cast a ballot. Pre-registered voters who are unable to show approved ID may sign an oath of identification for an election held in 2018. Voters who are not pre-registered or who have changed precincts also may be required to provide proof of residence. Any voter who cannot show ID may have their identity attested to by another voter in the precinct who has proper ID. Starting January 1, 2019, all voters will be required to present an approved form of identification.
