Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph. Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Rudolph, second by Contner to approve the minutes of April 9, 2018. Motion carried unanimously.

Chuck Wenthold reported IDNR completed a site visit to the proposed Tower's Pork in Section 30 Highland Township last week. The board intends to review master matrix scoring at its meeting April 23rd followed by a public hearing April 30<sup>th</sup>. Sheriff Jack Williams discussed costs to replace cameras for his department. Williams also reported on the storm and aftermath of straight-line winds that caused serious damage to several buildings, homes and other properties in Jefferson last Friday evening. Thomas Laehn reported the courthouse security committee's upcoming meeting and discussion whether to recommend (to the board of supervisors) hiring an outside consultant to perform a risk assessment for the courthouse.

Overnight travel requests from Thomas Laehn (trial outside county) and Michelle Fields (GIS training) were given informal approval. Supervisor Peter Bardole reported attending both Region XII Policy Council and Greene County Chamber meetings. Chair John Muir reported GCCSD superintendent Tim Christensen has requested that a representative of the board of supervisors attend a meeting with OPN Architects this Thursday related to the career academy.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Bardole to accept the Treasurer's Investment & Driver's License Fees for March. Motion carried unanimously. Treasurer Donna Lawson reported her drive examiner intends to retire in October.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 9:05 a.m.
