Greene County Board of Supervisors met in the courthouse boardroom at 8:30 a.m. with supervisors Burkett, Bardole, Contner, Muir and Rudolph present. Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to approve the minutes of June 8, 2020. Motion carried unanimously.

Chair John Muir reported attending a meeting of the Region XII COG Executive board. Supervisors Pete Bardole and Dawn Rudolph reported participation in meetings of GCDC voting board and Chamber, and Grow Greene County, respectively. Engineer Wade Weiss, participating electronically, reported road-graveling status (nearing completion), opening of the relocated airport road, and a temporary road closing to take place tomorrow. Weiss also updated the board with plans to bore a pipe beneath a county road for a drainage project, completion of Paton bridge project and Mahanay Tower work completed.

County attorney Thomas Laehn reported ten new criminal cases have been added to the eighty-six cases already pending. Laehn also informed the board about a bill awaiting the governor's signature after passing both houses of the legislature. If signed, the County's resolution prohibiting firearms or dangerous weapons in the courthouse will become void. To deny firearms or dangerous weapons, Laehn indicated the new legislation would require both screening of building entrants and armed security in the building.

At 9:00 a.m., motion by Contner, second by Burkett to adjourn to drainage meetings for DD14 completion hearing and related actions, and DD191 pay estimate #1 consideration. The board returned to its regular session at 9:30 a.m. Muir adjourned the meeting at 9:35 a.m.
