Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.
Motion by Burkett, second by Richardson to approve the minutes of November 17, 2014.

Supervisor Dawn Rudolph gave a report of a Partnership 4 Families meeting. Supervisor Guy Richardson reported attending a Region XII COG board meeting. Overnight travel was requested and approved for Sheriff Steve Hauptert and Chief Deputy Jack Williams.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to approve claims for payment. Motion carried unanimously.

GCDC director Ken Paxton was present to update the board on projects, activities and plans supported by Greene County Chamber and Development.

Chair John Muir read a summary of the proposed local option sales & services tax ordinance. Motion by Richardson, second by Burkett to approve the second reading of ordinance 2014-01: Local Option Sales & Services Tax. Roll call vote: Aye: Rudolph, Richardson, Muir, Contner, Burkett. Motion carried unanimously. The third & final reading of the proposed ordinance is scheduled for the board's next meeting.

Homestead credit and military exemption disallowances were reviewed by supervisors. Motion by Rudolph, second by Contner to approve 2014 homestead credit and military exemption disallowances as recommended by the assessor. Motion carried unanimously.
