Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Burkett, Contner, Muir, Richardson, Rudolph.

Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Richardson, second by Contner to approve the minutes of October 6, 2014. Motion carried unanimously.

City administrator Mike Palmer showed the board a power point presentation showing how Jefferson's local option sales and services (LOSST) tax monies have been spent. Currently the rural (unincorporated) of the county and all cities except Churdan have a question on the general election ballot as to whether the LOSST should be extended another ten years.

Supervisor Guy Richardson reported attending Region XII COG Executive Board and Policy Council meetings and a Kindergarten to College committee meeting. Supervisor Dawn Rudolph was also in attendance at the Policy Council meeting and a department head meeting. Rudolph reported on final decisions relating to the M&M RC&D dissolution.

Kevin Hicks requested that the board abate second half property taxes on a parcel purchased by the Rippey United Methodist Church for use as parking. Motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to approve abatement of 2013 taxes (\$210) on the property described as Original Rippey – Lot 13 Block 15. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, second by Contner to approve Resolution 2014-31:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Greene County Board of Supervisors recognizes Doug Sukovaty for his thirty-five plus years of service to the Greene County Secondary Roads Department. Doug's dedication and commitment to the Secondary Roads Department and Greene County residents are hereby noted and will be long remembered.

Motion by Richardson, second by Rudolph to approve proposed changes to the employee handbook as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to approve claims for payment. Motion carried unanimously.
