Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Burkett, Contner, Muir, Richardson, Rudolph.

Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.
Motion by Richardson, second by Burkett to approve the minutes of September 22, 2014.
Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisors gave reports of meetings and functions attended: Tom Contner for New Opportunities; Dawn Rudolph for Thomas Jefferson Gardens dedication, Scranton Library ribbon cutting and a regional mental health board meeting; Guy Richardson for Board of Health and Kindergarten to College meetings; and Mick Burkett for 2nd Judicial District Commission.

Motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to approve auditor signing of E911 checks. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to approve a mortgage satisfaction document on a former Regional Jumpstart Repair Program forgivable loan agreement property. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Contner, second by Richardson to appoint Justin Durlam as Bristol Township clerk. Motion carried unanimously.

Dan Towers and Michelle Fields requested the board to consider submission of a letter or resolution to support the regional collaboration of the fourteen communities along the Raccoon River Valley Trail (RRVT) with a common public art initiative. In establishing the RRVT as a regional resource, the Trail Association believes each trail community might benefit by being able to better secure grants and other funding and potentially be designated as an Iowa Great Place. A resolution will be considered at the board's next meeting.

The board heard a short report from engineer Wade Weiss. At 9:40 a.m., motion to adjourn by Richardson, second by Rudolph. Motion carried unanimously.
