Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with supervisors Burkett, Contner, Richardson and Rudolph present. Absent: Muir.

Motion by Burkett, second by Contner to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to approve the minutes of November 3, 2014. Motion carried unanimously.

Sanitarian Tim Healy reported receiving information about a new hog confinement (under the 2500 head threshold for the master matrix) in Dawson Township. Healy also reported that he will be setting up hearing dates for both the county zoning commission and the board of supervisors for a zoning change request from NEW Cooperative for anhydrous ammonia storage and building in Franklin Township.

City administrator Mike Palmer gave his monthly update of Jefferson projects and matters.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to accept the Recorder's Report of Fees for October. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Rudolph, second by Contner to accept the Treasurer's Investment & Driver's License Report for October. Motion carried unanimously.

Don Ihnken of the local VFW post updated the board on the status of repairs and improvements made to the facility.

Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to renew the county's health insurance plan with Wellmark and BCS (stop loss carrier) with recommended changes including no change to premium rates. Motion carried unanimously. The plan covers calendar 2015.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Contner to approve claims for payment. Motion carried unanimously.

Auditor Jane Heun reported that two Robert Gaines prints depicting the Mahanay Tower have been donated by Jane and Robert Gaines.

Engineer Wade Weiss asked that the board view the results of the courtroom stained glass dome & lighting restoration upon conclusion of the meeting.

At 9:30 a.m., motion to adjourn by Rudolph, second by Contner. Motion carried unanimously. The supervisors are to meet at 1:00 p.m. as a board of canvass for the November 4th general election.
