Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Burkett, Contner, Muir, Richardson, Rudolph.

Motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Richardson to approve the minutes of October 27, 2014. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Tom Contner reported attending a meeting of the New Opportunities board.

Bob Ausberger informed the board that he met with Kyle Ament, an environmental specialist with the Iowa Department of Natural Resources. During last week's board meeting Ausberger provided information about water quality demonstration project applications being accepted by the Iowa Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship. Ausberger noted that Ament recommended a larger watershed area than originally proposed by Ausberger and submission of an application at a date after the current round of applications are due. Chair John Muir told Ausberger that two supervisors would mostly likely attend a meeting held with the NRCS on the matter.

Motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to approve payment of \$16,958 to George White Chevrolet for a 2015 Tahoe for the sheriff's department. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, second by Contner to accept the Sheriff's Quarterly Report of Fees for July through September. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to approve a Class C beer permit for Paton Pit Stop. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Burkett, second by Richardson to approve an EMS Systems Development grant of \$5,416 for the period October 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015. Motion carried unanimously.

Sandy Scheuermann and Terry Lang were on hand to share county health insurance renewal information. Scheuermann reviewed current rates and claim information with Wellmark and stop loss carrier BCS, new proposed rates with the same parties, and rates with Cypress and stop loss carrier Optum/Unimerica. Scheuermann recommended keeping the same coverage with no increase to premiums. No action was taken.

At 10:10 a.m., motion to adjourn by Contner, second by Burkett. Motion carried unanimously.
