Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Burkett, Contner, Muir, Richardson, Rudolph.

Motion by Richardson, second by Contner to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to approve the minutes of October 31, 2016. Motion carried unanimously.

Under communications the board discussed the Honor Flight as it pertains to Greene County veterans. Vet Affairs director Tracie Perez and Engineer Wade Weiss participated in the discussion. General questions and concerns were discussed.

Pastor Dean Porter was present to make the board aware of and request approval for a bible-reading marathon on the courthouse grounds Friday, Saturday and possibly Sunday of this week. Porter noted that 86 counties have already had the marathon on their courthouse grounds since its initiation. The board agreed to the request.

Motion by Richardson, second by Contner to accept the Recorder's Report of Fees for October. Motion carried unanimously.

IT director Michelle Fields presented an amendment to the county's five year subscription agreement with Tyler Technologies for board consideration. The amendment extends the county's existing agreement for an additional five years, and sets the annual subscription rate at \$39,258 for each of the next five years. Motion by Richardson, second by Rudolph to approve Amendment to Subscription Agreement for Tyler Technology. Motion carried unanimously.

Engineer Wade Weiss discussed continued conversations regarding the Greene County School District's interest in the purchase of the old armory building owned by the county and used by the Secondary Roads department. Weiss discussed plans to build a cold storage building near existing Jefferson Secondary Roads buildings to replace the armory facility if sold. Terms of the sale have not yet been determined, and a hearing would be held regarding the proposal prior to any final determination. Weiss noted that he would provide more information at a later date.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 9:40 a.m.
