Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 10:00 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present for the special meeting: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph. Those present to lead the informational session about Public Health services included Heather Bombei, Regional Community Health Consultant, Iowa Department of Public Health (IDPH), and Becky Wolf, Public Health Director.

Bombei shared maps of Iowa's counties and their type of public health delivery system (affiliated with hospital or other health system vs stand-alone public health departments). Bombei encouraged the board, when comparing one county's system to another, to look at whether the public health entity is a certified Medicare provider, number of full time equivalent employees (FTE's), level of tax support, what services are provided, and whether the entity is county-based or hospital-based, and noting that comparisons may be difficult.

Wolf reviewed the Greene County's staffing and funding details for FY17, programs offered and staff hours expended for the numerous programs and services.

Supervisor questions were answered and they, in turn, thanked both Bombei and Wolf for the "lesson" on public health.

Chair Muir adjourned the session at 11:10 a.m.
