Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Burkett, Contner, Muir, Richardson, Rudolph.

Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to approve the minutes of March 16, 2015. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Dawn Rudolph gave reports of meetings, one for Partnership for Families and the other for the group working for a new animal shelter. Chair John Muir noted that he and other local individuals (Larry Teeples, Wade Weiss, Ken Paxton, Doug Burns) had participated in the Highway 30 Day at the Capitol. Larry Teeples gave a report of that meeting.

Muir recognized and presented a certificate to conservation director Dan Towers for his thirty years of service to Greene County.

Auditor Jane Heun shared two proposed ordinances pertaining to the county's annual tax sale. The first would allow the county and each city in the county to bid on and purchase delinquent taxes and to assign tax sale certificates of abandoned property (assessed as residential or commercial multifamily housing property) or vacant lots for use as housing per Iowa Code 446.19A. The second would authorize the county treasurer to separately offer and sell parcels that are abandoned property (assessed as residential or commercial multifamily housing property) and that are, or are likely to become, a public nuisance per Iowa Code 446.19B. Both will have first readings at the board's next meeting.

Engineer Wade Weiss reviewed patching project plans with the board for county roads P14 and E26. Motion by Richardson, second by Contner to approve signing final plans for Patching Project FM-CO37 (68) - - 55-37. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to approve claims for payment and auditor signing E911 checks. Motion carried unanimously.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 9:45 a.m.
