Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Burkett, Contner, Muir, Richardson, Rudolph.

Motion by Richardson, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Richardson to approve the minutes of December 8, 2014. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Mick Burkett reported attending a meeting of the Second Judicial District board; Guy Richardson reported attending meetings of Region XII COG executive board and GCDC.

Ben Yoder, Greene County chamber president, addressed the board regarding the Chamber board's vision for the Welcome Center in Jefferson. Yoder reviewed the history of the project, completion of the exterior, and plans for remodeling the center's interior. Yoder discussed Chamber membership information and funding of the center and asked that the supervisors consider a letter of support in favor of the Welcome Center and the center's role in tourism for the area.

Tom Wittrock asked the board to continue funding for Scranton congregate meals. Wittrock noted that meals are prepared in Jefferson and picked up for delivery to Scranton area residents, with a few delivered to the building site in Scranton. Wittrock requested continued support of \$1,750 to the program.

Motion by Richardson, second by Contner to approve Resolution 2014-33:

BE IT RESOLVED that the board of supervisors approves hiring Jeana Keller as part-time jailer effective December 3, 2014 at a rate of \$14/hour pending certification. Upon certification the rate will be \$15/hour.

Roll call vote: Aye: Burkett, Muir, Contner, Richardson, Rudolph. Motion carried unanimously.

Ken Paxton, executive director of Greene County Development Corp., provided the board with a list of proposed projects for calendar 2015 and a monthly status report of current projects and meetings scheduled. Current support of GCDC is at \$47,500, with the same requested for FY16.

Michelle Hull and Jackie Souder presented the funding request for RSVP of Boone & Greene Counties. Hull reviewed programs and services provided in Greene County and requested continued support of \$2,000 to be used toward the required match needed for federal dollars received.

Erich Kretzinger, executive director of Habitat for Humanity of Boone & Greene Counties, gave a report of Habitat's Helping Hands home repair program for 2014, providing before and after photos of two smaller projects and one major renovation project in Jefferson. Kretzinger is looking to again provide Helping Hands home repair in outlying Greene County communities as per board recommendation, pending qualifying applications. Kretzinger tentatively requested continued support of \$5,000.

Motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to approve a fireworks permit for Diane Wise. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Burkett, second by Contner to accept the Treasurer's Investment and Driver's License Report for November. Motion carried unanimously.

At 10:35 a.m., motion to adjourn by Contner, second by Rudolph. Motion carried unanimously.
