Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Burkett, Contner, Muir, Richardson, Rudolph.

Motion by Richardson, second by Contner to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Richardson to approve the minutes of April 27, 2015. Motion carried unanimously.

Deb McGinn of the Tower View team and Jefferson Matters: Main Street provided the board with an update of plans and events including requests to use the courthouse plaza for a meet & greet with new Main Street director Peg Raney on May 20th and a Rooftop Art dedication ceremony on June 6th. McGinn related plans for the alley west of the Square and a Greene Bell Pepper Challenge sponsored by Main Street during the Bell Tower Festival. The board agreed to use of the grounds.

Drew Sorenson addressed the supervisors asking the board to consider planting additional trees on the courthouse grounds now in anticipation of loss of ash trees to the emerald ash borer.

Chris Henning requested and received the go-ahead to use the courthouse grounds for the annual Farmer's Market scheduled to run June 2nd through September 29th.

Supervisor Guy Richardson gave a report of a seminar he had attended with IT director Michelle Fields related to cyber security. Richardson also noted attendance at the Greene County Community Impact award ceremony where he presented a plaque to Alice Walters, award recipient. Supervisor Mick Burkett reported attending a Pioneer Cemetery commission meeting.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Richardson to set a public hearing for an amendment to the FY15 county budget on Tuesday, May 26th at 9:00 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Burkett, second by Richardson to accept the Recorder's Report of Fees for April. Motion carried unanimously.

Chair John Muir adjourned the meeting at 9:15 a.m.
