Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Burkett, Contner, Muir, Richardson, Rudolph.

Motion by Richardson, second by Burkett to approve the agenda, amended to include two additional fireworks permit requests. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Richardson to approve the minutes of June 6, 2016. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Guy Richardson reported attending the Vision Iowa CAT grant presentation last week at which the Mahanay Memorial Carillon Expansion project was awarded \$87,102.

Deb McGinn (Jefferson Matters: Main Street Tower View Team) reported the names of the top three "Ring Out For Art" sculpture winners announced during the Bell Tower Festival. Those three sculptures will remain on display on the courthouse plaza until May 1, 2017.

Vicky Lautner, Jefferson park & rec director, requested a letter of support for a grant application to the National Parks Commission. Lautner seeks to have the bike trail, city parks, Daubendiek Park and the school all connected in some manner and is seeking grant funds to help determine how this might be accomplished. Lautner also indicated that in-kind assistance would also be appreciated. A letter of support is to be considered at another meeting.

Jefferson city administrator Mike Palmer provided his monthly report of progress on various current city projects and upcoming projects and activities.

At 9:00 a.m., motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to adjourn to a drainage meeting for DD108 completion hearing and then for DD2 tentative approval of Engineer's Report – report & improvement investigation. Motion carried unanimously. The board returned to regular session at 9:20 a.m.

Motion by Contner, second by Richardson to approve fireworks permits for Eric Brincks, Deanna McDonald and Jack Williams. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to accept the Treasurer's Investment and Driver's License Report for May. Motion carried unanimously.

An overnight travel request for Marcia Tasler for the Recorder summer conference was informally approved.

Motion by Richardson, second by Contner to approve claims for payment. Motion carried unanimously.
