Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Burkett, Contner, Muir, Richardson, Rudolph.

Motion by Burkett, second by Contner to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.
Motion by Richardson, second by Rudolph to approve the minutes of September 26, 2016.
Motion carried unanimously.

John McCormick and Tim Towers, Highland Township trustees, were present for the township's request for funding assistance (Dreyfus grant) for an improved highway entrance to the township cemetery. The higher costs associated with an entrance off a state highway versus off any other road were discussed at length, with county engineer Wade Weiss discussing those requirements. Motion by Richardson, second by Burkett to award \$2,500 in Dreyfus funds to assist with the project. Motion carried unanimously.

There was general discussion until the board's next item at 10:00 a.m. Engineer Weiss discussed the status of the tower project and an up-coming reenactment program that will be held on October 16th in honor of the tower's fiftieth anniversary. Discussion also included improvements that Weiss would like to make to some of the secondary roads maintenance sheds.

Chair John Muir opened two bids received for the stained glass dome restoration project planned for the courthouse. Bovard Studio, Fairfield, Iowa bid \$123,403. The Stained Glass Store, Des Moines, Iowa bid \$109,640. The bid documents will be reviewed for necessary information before any award is made.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 10:15 a.m.
