Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph. Motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Bardole to approve the minutes of September 5, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.

Chair John Muir reported attending meetings of Region XII COG Executive Board and the Chief Elected Officials board. Supervisor Dawn Rudolph reported on Board of Health and Freedom Rock meetings attended. Overnight travel requests to attend a fall training conference for county attorney Nick Martino and assistant Thomas Laehn were informally approved.

City of Jefferson administrator Mike Palmer updated the board on city projects and activities, including a candidate workshop for the upcoming city elections in November. Proposed signage pertaining to the courthouse square (signage uses bell tower square) was also discussed.

The board reviewed master matrix scoring of the proposed Youngblood Site (owner Bruce Youngblood) in Section 25 of Bristol Township. Chuck Wenthold reported the site scored 450 points and includes a closure plan. Pinnacle representative Kent Krause and Bruce and Amy Youngblood were present for the review. Wenthold reported the IDNR site visit is planned later this week, and a public hearing is scheduled at 9:00 a.m. on September 18th.

Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to accept the Recorder's Report of Fees for August. Motion carried unanimously.

The board reviewed master matrix scoring of the proposed Kave Farm Finisher Site (owner Grey Owl VI, LLC) in Section 27 of Highland Township. Chuck Wenthold reported the site scored 450 points and includes a closure plan. When questioned who the owner specifically is, Wenthold noted the contact persons are through Iowa Select Farms. Darrell Hunt of New Modern Concepts, builder of the site, was also present for the discussion. The site visit by the IDNR is scheduled later this week, with a public hearing to be held at 9:30 a.m. during the September 18th meeting of the board of supervisors.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Contner to approve claims for payment. Motion carried unanimously.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 9:50 a.m.
