Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Burkett, Contner, Muir, Richardson, Rudolph.

Motion by Richardson, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to approve the minutes of October 3, 2016. Motion carried unanimously.

Jefferson city administrator Mike Palmer addressed the board with his monthly update of downtown and other activities and projects. Palmer discussed the animal shelter and updating the current 28E the city has with the county for shelter costs.

Genesis Development CEO Terry Johnson was present to provide the board with an update of the agency's work for persons with disabilities. Johnson noted that the Hope Wellness Center operated by Genesis in Woodward is performing well. He discussed collections from managed care organizations and plans for adding or expanding mobile crisis intervention and other services. Johnson thanked the board for its part in supporting the county's mental health region and its programs.

Motion by Richardson, second by Burkett to accept the Recorder's Report of Fees for September. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Rudolph, second by Richardson to accept the Auditor's Quarterly Report of Passport Fees for July, August, September. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Burkett, second by Contner to approve claims for payment. Motion carried unanimously.
