Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with supervisors Bardole, Burkett, Muir and Rudolph present. Absent: Contner.

Motion by Burkett, second by Bardole to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Bardole, second by Rudolph to approve the minutes of the January 30, 2017 regular session and January 30, 2017 special joint session with city of Jefferson. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Dawn Rudolph reported attending a Freedom Rock committee meeting. Chair John Muir reported that he and Sheriff Williams met with several mayors and clerks regarding county law enforcement services. Muir and Supervisor Pete Bardole also reported for a Greene County Community Development project planning meeting that they attended.

Jefferson councilman Larry Teeples encouraged the board to become members of the Highway 30 Coalition group whose efforts are directed at expansion of the highway. Chuck Wenthold shared a Winneshiek County resolution requesting the state to address the failings of the master matrix.

Motion by Bardole, second by Rudolph to approve the tentative agreement reached between the County and PPME Local 2003 (Secondary roads employees). Motion carried unanimously.

Dan Towers and Michelle Fields addressed the board on behalf of the Trailhead Development group's application for funding for signage on the bike trail. Fields noted that the county, as fiscal agent, would act as the path for receipt and disbursement of funds for the project. Total project costs are reported at \$171,036 with grants applied for as funding sources. No action was taken.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 10:00 a.m.
