Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with supervisors Burkett, Contner, Richardson and Rudolph present. Absent: Muir.

Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to approve the minutes of March 2, 2015. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Dawn Rudolph reported attending the Historical Museum's hosting of Lt. Governor Kim Reynolds and her Story of Women's Lives Tour. Custodian Mike Wyatt reported on some plumbing problems being dealt with on the courthouse third floor.

Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to approve claims for payment and auditor signing E911 checks. Motion carried unanimously.

Jefferson city administrator Mike Palmer updated the supervisors with the latest news on city development items including information about the planned airport expansion.

Peg Raney, Bell Tower Community Foundation member, and Pat Richards, tower supervisor and tour guide, addressed the board regarding the upcoming 50th year anniversary of the tower in 2016. Raney discussed a tower grant application submitted for consideration by the Greene County Community Foundation to help fund some of the items needing replacement or updating inside the tower. She discussed the county's involvement for some of the interior repairs to be made to floor and wall tile and to a ceiling fan, providing estimates she has received for the materials and labor. Richards related her experience as tower guide supervisor and explained that the tower has attracted a variety of interested persons and groups for both tours and rentals on special occasions. A season pass to the tower is new for 2015.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to accept the Recorder's Report of Fees for February. Motion carried unanimously.

Chair Pro Tem Guy Richardson adjourned the meeting at 9:35 a.m.
