Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with supervisors Bardole, Contner, Muir and Rudolph. Absent: Burkett.

Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Bardole, second by Contner to approve the minutes of March 13, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.

Reports of other meetings attended by supervisors included Heart of Iowa Community Services board by Dawn Rudolph, Region XII Executive board by John Muir, and a Jefferson city council meeting by Peter Bardole.

During open forum Bob Ausberger presented an informational sign depicting the historical Scranton water tower for Supervisor Rudolph to deliver to Scranton. Ausberger shared a handout reporting energy savings achieved from the solar panel installed at Grand Junction and then discussed the meeting held for the east entryway corridor vision plan meeting.

Michele Hull of RSVP inquired whether the board (and Greene County employees) would again partner with RSVP on a food drive as part of County & Local Officials Day of National Service. The board agreed to hold the event later in April.

Pam Olerich presented recommended family farm credit disallowances for board approval. Motion by Rudolph, second by Bardole to approve the disallowances as recommended. Motion carried unanimously.

A list of current county ordinances by titles/subject matter was distributed to the supervisors for compilation as part of a five-year update to the county's code of ordinances. First consideration of the ordinance compiling the Greene County Code of Ordinances is scheduled for the board meeting on March 27th.

The board next acted as a board of canvassers for the special school election held March 14, 2017 to fill one vacancy on the Greene County Consolidated School District board. The canvass resulted in 350 votes for Steve Fisher, 190 for Matt Wetrich and one write-in.

Engineer Wade Weiss reported to the board before adjournment.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 9:55 a.m.
