Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Burkett, Contner, Muir, Richardson, Rudolph.

Motion by Contner, second by Richardson to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to approve the minutes of February 17, 2015. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Dawn Rudolph reported that she had attended meetings of Partnership for Families and Decat boards and the governor's visit to Greene County. Chair John Muir reported attending meetings of Central Iowa Juvenile Detention commission, department heads, the Bully Project and Senator Joni Ernst's visit to the VFW to discuss Home Base Iowa. Supervisor Guy Richardson also participated in the department head meeting and the governor's visit.

Sid Jones was present during open forum to discuss his idea for a community development director position to oversee various county organizations: Chamber, Main Street, Greene County Development Corporation and Greene County Community Foundation.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to approve the Second Amendment to Lease Agreement between Greene County and the Iowa Department of Administrative Services for the period July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2018. Motion carried unanimously. The lease agreement covers space in the courthouse for Targeted Case Management offices.

Overnight travel was informally approved for Deputy Kirk Hammer.

Engineer Wade Weiss discussed a request he had received regarding the Hwy 4 overpass.

Motion by Burkett, second by Richardson to approve claims for payment. Motion carried unanimously.
