Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with supervisors Burkett, Contner and Richardson present. Absent: Muir and Rudolph. Supervisor Guy Richardson opened the meeting at 8:45 a.m.

Motion by Burkett, second by Contner to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve the minutes of August 22, 2016. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve a fireworks permit for Norm Fandel. Motion carried unanimously.

Chair John Muir arrived at the meeting at 8:50 a.m. County attorney Nick Martino presented a three-year contract (order subscription) with West Publishing Corporation for Westlaw PRO™ services. Motion by Richardson, second by Burkett to approve the agreement with West Publishing Corporation as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

At 9:00 a.m., motion by Richardson, second by Contner to adjourn to a drainage meeting for hearings on DD2 Engineer's Report, Annexation, and Reclassification. Motion carried unanimously. The board returned to its regular session at 10:40 a.m.

GCDC director Ken Paxton updated the board with the results of a Greene County Workforce Housing Study conducted in June of this year. Paxton reviewed the results of the housing survey that received over 800 responses from respondents living in the county (75%) and those commuting to work in the county (25%). A summary of the housing inventory-lookers in the report states that the workforce respondents "...currently looking for a change in housing consider the Greene County inventory inadequate for their needs". Paxton provided a copy of the report to each supervisor for review.

Motion by Richardson, second by Burkett to approve E911 checks for auditor signing. Motion carried unanimously.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 11:00 a.m.
