Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Burkett, Contner, Muir, Richardson, Rudolph.

Motion by Contner, second by Richardson to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to approve the minutes of January 29, 2015. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Tom Contner reported attending a meeting of the New Opportunities board. Chris Henning introduced Jean Claude Nzamba and Boukari Nougara, a businessman from Burkina Faso, a country in West Africa. Nougara is in Iowa visiting and learning more about cattle operations.

At 9:10, Chair John Muir opened a public hearing to take comments for the proposed FY16 Emergency Management. The board of supervisors serves as the agency's commission. The budget reflects a county contribution of \$25,000, expenditures estimated at \$26,950, and ending cash balance of \$4,708. Motion by Richardson, second by Contner to close the hearing at 9:20 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Burkett, second by Contner to adopt and certify the FY16 Greene County Emergency Management Commission budget. Motion carried unanimously.

Dennis Morlan, county coordinator for emergency management operations, reported on the county's cooperative efforts to provide services in emergencies. Morlan also reviewed the county's ambulance budget and the condition of the three county-owned ambulances, noting that the board should consider when it plans to purchase another ambulance. In addition, Morlan reported on medical examiner case numbers for 2014.

Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to designate Dennis Morlan as primary contact to access the Statewide Mass Notification and Emergency Messaging System. Motion carried unanimously.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 10:10 a.m.
