Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with supervisors Burkett, Contner, Muir and Richardson present. Absent: Rudolph.

Motion by Burkett, second by Contner to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Richardson, second by Burkett to approve the minutes of June 22, 2015. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Mick Burkett reported attending meetings of the Pioneer Cemetery Commission and 2nd Judicial District Board. Supervisor Guy Richardson reported attending a Bell Tower Foundation meeting.

During open forum Shane Olson and the board again discussed Olson's request for an engine brake ordinance. No action has been taken. IT director Michelle Fields discussed record requests she has received in the past from out-of-state parties. She noted that ISAC has provided a sample Open Records Policy and recommended the board review it and consider implementing such a policy to fit the county's needs in complying with Iowa Code Chapter 22 (Iowa Open Records Law) provisions. Assessor Linda Spearman discussed implementing an industrial tax exemption for new construction in the county in accordance with Iowa Code 427B.

Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve fireworks permits for Rhonda Gibson, Larry Monthei, Bill Sutton, Alan Betts, Dale Higgins. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Contner, second by Richardson to approve claims for payment and auditor signing of E911 checks. Motion carried unanimously.

Chair John Muir noted that the county has received a construction permit application for S & A Partners, LLC (Scott Walker & Adam Bauer interested parties) for a proposed finishing unit in Section 25 of Paton Township. A public hearing will be scheduled.

Engineer Wade Weiss reported on the roads after last week's heavy rains.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 9:35 a.m.
