Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph. Motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Contner to approve the minutes of May 15, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Bardole informed the board that the Bell Tower Foundation would like for the supervisors to be present at the opening ceremony of the Bell Tower Festival. They are planning a rededication of the bells during the opening ceremony. Muir and Rudolph reported on a department head meeting that they both attended. Muir reported on attending a Region XII meeting. Environmental Health Director, Chuck Wenthold reported on attending a Raccoon Watershed Meeting.

The Board informally approved overnight travel for county recorder Marcia Tasler to attend the recorder summer conference in Okoboji.

Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to approve a cigarette/tobacco/vapor products permit for Paton Pit Stop, LLC. Motion carried unanimously.

Engineer Wade Weiss updated the board on the timeline of the bells being reinstalled on the bell tower and other issues that are of concern with the bell tower at this time. He also updated the board on other secondary roads projects.
