Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with supervisors Bardole, Burkett, Contner and Rudolph. Absent: Muir.

Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Bardole, second by Burkett to approve the minutes of April 17, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.

A written request for use of the east side parking area and courthouse plaza for the 2017 Farmers Market was received from Chris Henning. This year's season will run on Tuesdays from 4 until 6:00 p.m. during the months of June through September, with no market on July 4th. The board agreed to the request.

Supervisors' meeting reports included Peter Bardole for the Airport commission; Dawn Rudolph for Heart of Iowa Community Services, Decat, Region XII Policy Council, Partnership for Families, site visit with IDNR for Eason Feedlots; Mick Burkett and Tom Contner for department head meeting; Contner for Recycling commission.

Michelle Fields discussed work requested for DD14 noting that a request for an engineer's report may be included on the board's agenda for its next meeting.

Motion by Burkett, second by Contner to approve claims for payment. Motion carried unanimously.

Chuck Wenthold reviewed master matrix scoring for Eason Feedlots proposed buildings in Section 6 of Jackson Township. The proposed construction is for two new deep bedded, deep pack confinements for an additional 900 head of cattle at the facility to keep everything on the site totally contained. The master matrix scoring is 485, with 440 points being the minimum requirement. Those attending on behalf of Eason Feedlots included Robert and Curt Eason, Ryan and Brent Schroeder and Becky Sexton of Twin Lakes Environmental Services. A public hearing is scheduled for the board's May 1st meeting at 9:00 a.m.

Pam Olerich, Tax & Real Estate coordinator addressed the board on the topic of tax increment financing after an impromptu request from them to do so.

Engineer Wade Weiss provided an update of the bell tower carillon project.

Rudolph adjourned the meeting at 9:40 a.m.
