Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph.

Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to approve the minutes of January 26, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.

Chuck Wenthold reported that the county Board of Adjustment will meet on February 7th at 11:00 a.m. consider conditional use permits for the Beaver Creek wind project. Supervisor Peter Bardole reported attending the Chamber's annual meeting.

Ellen Ritter, county mental health coordinator, provided an update of her work and participation for the Heart of Iowa community services region. Ritter said she is working to spread the word about services in the region.

Laura Ballard addressed the board regarding mentoring, noting that January is national mentoring month. Ballard related that February will be mentoring month in Greene County. Chair John Muir then read a proclamation declaring February as mentoring month in Greene County.

Chair Muir opened a public hearing for taking bids for a county property in Dana. One sealed bid of \$200 was received from Doug Fouch for the property. Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to close the hearing. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to approve Resolution 2017-07:

WHEREAS Greene County wishes to dispose of its interest in property described as "Lot A of Lot 23 of the SW1/4 SW1/4 of Section 4, Township 84 North, Range 29 West of the 5th P.M., Greene County, Iowa (locally known as 207 N Dana St., Dana), and

WHEREAS Greene County has held a public hearing on the proposed sale and has received a bid for the described property,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Greene County accepts a bid of \$200 from Doug Fouch in exchange for a quit claim deed to the property, free and clear of any real estate taxes and special assessments.

Roll call vote: Aye: Burkett, Contner, Bardole, Rudolph, Muir. Motion carried unanimously.

Engineer Wade Weiss discussed a grant application and contents with the board. Motion by Burkett, second by Bardole to approve a grant application to the Grow Greene County Gaming Corp. for restoration of the stained glass dome in the courthouse rotunda. Motion carried unanimously.

The board reviewed clerk of court and general services budgets for FY18 prior to adjournment.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 10:00 a.m.
