Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Burkett, Contner, Muir, Richardson, Rudolph.

Motion by Richardson, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to approve the minutes of November 7, 2016. Motion carried unanimously.

Jefferson city administrator Mike Palmer gave an update of city projects and happenings, noting that the city has a lot of plans and projects in the works.

At 9:00 a.m., motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to adjourn to a drainage public hearing for DD27 Surface Drain repair. Motion carried unanimously. The board returned to regular session at 9:55 a.m.

Motion by Richardson, second by Rudolph to approve an FY17 EMS System Development Grant with the Iowa Department of Public Health, with Billie Jo Hoskins as authorized signatory for the county. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, second by Rudolph to approve Resolution 2016-33 to Dispose of Greene County's Interest in real property by sale to the Greene County Community School District:

WHEREAS the Greene County Board of Supervisors (Board) proposes to dispose of its interest in real property by sale to the Greene County Community School District in accordance with a real estate agreement, and

WHEREAS that property, formerly known as the National Guard Armory, is legally described as:

Lot 3 of the SE1/4 of Section 9, Township 83, Range 30, Greene County, Iowa, and

WHEREAS Iowa Code 331.361(2.) requires the Board to set forth its proposal in a resolution and publish notice of the time and place of a public hearing on the proposal in accordance with Section 331.305,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Greene County sets a public hearing date during its regular meeting on November 21, 2016 at 9:15 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom, after which a determination may be made on the real estate sale agreement by resolution of the Board.

Roll call vote: Aye: Burkett, Contner, Muir, Richardson, Rudolph. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Richardson to approve claims for payment and auditor signing of E911 checks. Motion carried unanimously.

The board took a ten minute recess before returning as a board of canvass for the General Election held November 8, 2016. Those supervisors present for the canvass included Burkett, Contner, Muir and Rudolph. The results of that canvass are available in the office of the county auditor.
