Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph.

Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to approve the minutes of January 19, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Peter Bardole reported attending Central Iowa Juvenile Detention Center commission meeting as well as a two-day school for new county officers. Dawn Rudolph reported on a Partnership for Families meeting she attended.

At 9:00 a.m. Chair John Muir opened a public hearing for comments on a proposed amendment to the county's FY17 budget. Proposed revenue and expenditures changes were reviewed by Auditor Jane Heun. Motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to close the public hearing. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Burkett, second by Contner to approve Resolution 2017-06:

WHEREAS a public hearing has been held for a proposed amendment to the fiscal year 2017 Greene County budget as required by Iowa Code 331.43, and

WHEREAS no written or oral objections have been received on the proposed amendment.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Greene County Board of Supervisors adopts said budget amendment, and

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that the funds for the amended expenditure categories be fully appropriated for the 2017 fiscal year.

Aye: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph. Resolution carried unanimously.

Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to approve claims for payment. Motion carried unanimously.

The proposed Emergency Management Commission budget for FY18 was reviewed by the supervisors (who form the emergency management commission). An amendment to the current FY17 emergency management budget was also reviewed. Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to approve setting a public hearing for this budget and amendment at 9:00 a.m. on February 13, 2017 in the courthouse boardroom. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to approve IDPH County Substance Abuse grant semiannual report. Motion carried unanimously.

A proposed letter of support for a Freedom Rock grant funding request to the Greene County Community Foundation was read by Rudolph. Motion by Burkett, second by Bardole to approve the letter of support from the board. Motion carried unanimously.

Marcia Tasler reviewed her proposed FY18 Recorder revenue and expenditure budgets with the supervisors. Tasler requested an increase of \$3,480, or 2.66% to her operating budget. Revenues are estimated at \$61,000 for recording and other fees collected. No action was taken.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 9:45 a.m.
