Greene County Board of Supervisors met in the courthouse boardroom at 8:30 a.m. with all supervisors present: Burkett, Contner, Muir, Richardson, Rudolph.

Motion by Contner, second by Richardson to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to approve the minutes of June 13, 2016.

Supervisors Tom Contner and Guy Richardson reported attending department head and Board of Health meetings, respectively. Engineer Wade Weiss reported on the stained glass dome rehabilitation project, noting that he hopes to have bids in early October with the project completed by July of 2017.

Boone County attorney Dan Kolacia was present for the consideration of a 28E agreement for Boone, Greene & Sac County Collection of Delinquent Court Obligations. The board previously discussed participating with the two counties for these collections. Motion by Richardson, second by Rudolph to approve the 28E agreement as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Mary Weaver was present to request a letter of support for the Thomas Jefferson Gardens to refurbish the interior of the building into a visitor and educational center. Motion by Rudolph, second by Richardson to approve a letter of support for the Thomas Jefferson Gardens. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Burkett, second by Richardson to approve Resolution 2016-16:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Greene County Board of Supervisors approves hiring Sandra Groves as a part time telecommunicator effective June 23, 2016, at a rate of \$14 per hour, with the rate to be \$15 per hour upon certification.

Motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to approve a fireworks permit for Dale Higgins. Motion carried unanimously.
