Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Burkett, Contner, Muir, Richardson, Rudolph.

Motion by Richardson, second by Rudolph to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Rudolph, second by Richardson to approve the minutes of July 25, 2016. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Dawn Rudolph gave reports of an animal shelter meeting and a Freedom Rock meeting that she attended. Jefferson mayor Craig Berry informed the board that the city has received complaints about the use of jake brakes and is discussing whether or not the brakes, if used in town, should have to be muffled. An overnight travel request from county attorney Nick Martino was informally approved.

The board reviewed master matrix scoring on Felix Finisher Farm Site (Granite Farms IV) in Section 19 of Bristol Township. Environmental health director Chuck Wenthold noted that the proposed site scores 460 points (440 maximum required) and that a closure plan has been included for this site. Darrell Hunt of New Modern Concepts, builder of hog barns, was present for this review. A public hearing is scheduled for 9:00 a.m. at the board's next meeting August 8<sup>th</sup>.

Motion by Richardson, second by Rudolph to reschedule a public hearing for DD2 on August 29<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, second by Rudolph to approve Resolution 2016-24:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Greene County Board of Supervisors approves the hiring of Stacy Myers as part time jailer at \$14/hour. Upon certification, the rate will increase to \$15/hour.

Roll call vote: Ayes: Burkett, Contner, Muir, Richardson, Rudolph. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Burkett, second by Richardson to approve Resolution 2016-25:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Greene County Board of Supervisors appoints current County Veteran Services director Tracie Perez as General Assistance director for a combined County Veteran Services/General Assistance director at no increase to the Perez's current salary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Perez may receive an increase of \$1,000 (annual) after a six month probationary period and a favorable review of the general assistance position.

Roll call vote: Aye: Rudolph, Richardson, Burkett, Contner, Muir. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, second by Rudolph to approve the Greene County Substance Abuse Prevention grant FY16 year-end report. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Burkett, second by Contner to approve a fireworks permit request for Russ Grossman on September 17<sup>th</sup>, subject to compliance with any open burning bans at that time. Motion carried unanimously.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 9:30 a.m.
