Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph.

Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to approve the minutes of February 27, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Dawn Rudolph reported attending the "pastries & politics" meeting in Jefferson with our state legislator and senator on Saturday. Rudolph mentioned many of the topics of discussion at the gathering. Supervisor Peter Bardole reported attending a meeting of the airport commission.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Bardole to accept the Recorder's Report of Fees for February. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisors had general discussion about their impressions of the community development meeting they recently attended where the main presenter was Zachary Mannheimer. The meeting was directed at providing information about the launch of a long term community development project to make the county a destination for families and employees to Greene County. The county is being asked to consider participating in the initial proposal to complete the Community 360 Assessment and Plan Development. Total cost is \$98,000, with \$24,000 being requested of the county. Supervisors discussed pros and cons of participating in the funding with no decision being considered at this time.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 10:05 a.m.
