Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with supervisors Burkett, Contner, Muir and Richardson present. Absent: Rudolph.

Motion by Richardson, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Contner to approve the minutes of August 15, 2016. Motion carried unanimously.

Chair Muir gave reports of a department head meeting and a meeting with Iowa Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) officials in Fort Dodge (pertaining to master matrix scoring) that he and Chuck Wenthold, environmental health director, attended.

The board reviewed master matrix scoring (totaling 450 points) for JEMMB Pork Site, Mitch and Jill Stream. The construction application is for expansion of an existing site in Section 28 of Highland Township. Wenthold related that the scoring includes points taken for a closure plan, with the IDNR site visit scheduled on August 19th. Mitch Stream and Twin Lakes Environmental Services representative Larry Heschke were both present for questions from the board. A public hearing is scheduled during the board's next meeting on August 22nd.

The board reviewed master matrix scoring (totaling 480 points) for Hardin Site, Travis and Lynn Hardin. The construction application is for a new two-barn site in Section 23 of Bristol Township. Wenthold again related that the scoring includes points taken for a closure plan, with the IDNR site visit scheduled on August 25th. A public hearing is scheduled during the board's next meeting on August 22nd. John Everly, with the Pinnacle Group, was present for the scoring review.

IT director Michelle Fields briefly reported to the board, noting plans to consolidate internet lines within the courthouse.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 9:45 a.m.
