Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph.

Motion by Burkett, second by Bardole to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Bardole, second by Rudolph to approve the minutes of February 16, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Dawn Rudolph gave reports of meetings that she attended: Decat board, local Farm Bureau (with John Muir), Public Health board, and Partnership for Families board. Supervisor Pete Bardole reported for three meetings that he attended: Central Iowa Juvenile Detention commission, GCDC, and Bell Tower Foundation board.

Supervisors reviewed the county's proposed FY18 budget document reflecting changes requested during the previous budget work session. Budget levies and estimated ending fund balances were compared to current year figures. The countywide levy is proposed at \$5.65/\$1000, while the rural services levy is proposed at \$3.20/\$1000 of taxable valuation. The proposed consolidated rate of \$8.85 is one cent higher than the current year's consolidated rate. No additional changes were offered, with final budget figures to be in the public hearing notice scheduled for publication next week. The county's budget hearing is March 13th at 9:00 a.m.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 9:25 a.m.
