Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Burkett, Contner, Muir, Richardson, Rudolph.

Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.
Motion by Rudolph, second by Richardson to approve the minutes of November 30, 2015.
Motion carried unanimously.

Chair John Muir reported on the annual IDDA meeting held in Fort Dodge that he and drain clerk Michelle Fields attended.

Environmental Health director Chuck Wenthold reported that Public Health is applying for a small radon grant for 50 kits which would be available in his office and at Public Health. Motion by Richardson, second by Contner to approve a Letter of Support for the radon grant application.
Motion carried unanimously.

Michele Hull and Jackie Souder were present to review RSVP 55+ Volunteer Program in Greene & Boone Counties. Hull requested support totaling \$3,000 for FY17, up from current support of \$2,000. No action was taken.

Motion by Richardson, second by Rudolph to approve "Certificate of Agreement for Assignment of Certificate of Purchase" with the city of Jefferson for an assignment of a tax sale certificate.
Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Contner, second by Richardson, to approve a Class C native wine permit for Deal's Orchard. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, second by Burkett to accept the Recorder's Report of Fees for November.
Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve auditor signing of E911 checks. Motion carried unanimously.

Engineer Wade Weiss informed the board of an upcoming visit with a representative from Shuck-Britson (a structural engineering firm) to examine the bell tower.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 10:00 a.m.
