Dear Dust Control Purchaser:

In order to provide a quality dust control solution for residents of Greene County along with controlling cost, application timing and product quality, the Greene County Secondary Road Department will be applying dust suppressant for 2020. Calcium Chloride is still the most effective and efficient dust suppressant available to improve the road and reduce the dust around your home and property.

To purchase your dust control please complete the attached forms and attach a check made payable to ***Greene County Secondary Road Department*** for the appropriate amount. The Greene County Courthouse is currently closed to the public so you can either mail the forms and check to the Greene County Engineer at 114 N Chestnut, Jefferson, Iowa 50129, or place in the drop box located on the east side of the courthouse. Flags to mark your treatment area will be available next to the drop box. **Please have your forms and check to us by May 1, 2020.**

Dust Control prices will increase slightly this year due to increased material costs the past two years. The Greene County Board of Supervisors have chosen once again to charge only for the material applied and provide the application labor and equipment at no cost.

- The cost for a **single application** of Calcium Chloride is \$190.00 for a 400 ft. application. The minimum length is 400 feet with additional footage purchased in 100 ft. increments for \$47.50 each.
- The cost for **two applications** of Calcium Chloride is \$380.00 for a 400 ft. application. The minimum length is 400 feet with additional footage purchased in 100 ft. increments for \$95.00 each.

Please mark your treatment area by May 4 at which time, weather permitting, we will begin road preparation and application. If your treatment area is not marked, we will center the application at your house site. The dust suppressant will be applied and measured by a truck mounted instrument to ensure correct length of placement area.

The county reserves the right to lightly blade the dust suppression areas when necessary for the safety of the traveling public. Typically, this does not damage your dust control and will promote better dust suppression for you.
